### PATIENT TRACKING TRAIN-THE-TRAINER ACTIVITIES

### **Facility Evacuation Scenario:**

At this very moment, you hear the fire alarms sounding in your facility. Within moments, you can see and smell heavy smoke beginning to fill the area. You begin an immediate full evacuation. It quickly becomes evident that your facility will not be operational for an extended period of time. You are tasked with tracking all of the patients/residents and staff leaving your facility as they are transported to other facilities in the region who are able to receive them and provide for their appropriate level of care and/or treatment.

Activity 1: Log in to VHASS and access the Patient Tracking platform. Using the list of names provided to you by your HR Staff, enter all of your facility's patients/residents/staff who are being evacuated out of your facility.

Activity 2: Transfer all Evacuees to a different facility/location.

Activity 3: Your facility has received patients/residents and/or staff that had to be evacuated due to a fire in their facility. Using the *Patient Tracking* platform in VHASS, view the list of total Evacuees received into your facility. (Update (edit) with any new/additional details, if available. BE CREATIVE and add a few things for practice!)
