Expired / Outdated Inventory

1. VHEMP has a formalized process for getting rid of expired or outdated HPP procured inventory
2. There are two processes depending on what items we are referencing
3. For assets in particular; if the item is in working condition, then regional stakeholders have the right to request ownership of that item
4. If no one in the region wants the item, then the other Virginia HCCs have to submit requests or denials for that item.
5. If this proves to be unsuccessful then the item can be officially decommissioned by SVHC through a formal process



Regional HVA

- As it currently stands SVHC will continue the process towards updating the regional Hazard Vulnerability Assessment.
- We will open up a survey that will allow you to answer questions directly or upload a copy of your regional HVA.
- That information will be compiled and shared in early 2026 for publication.
