Expired / Outdated Inventory



- VHEMP has a formalized process for getting rid of expired or outdated HPP procured inventory
- 2. There are two processes depending on what items we are referencing
- 3. For assets in particular; if the item is in working condition, then regional stakeholders have the right to request ownership of that item
 - 4. If no one in the region wants the item, then the other Virginia HCCs have to submit requests or denials for that item.
 - 5. If this proves to be unsuccessful then the item can be officially decommissioned by SVHC through a formal process

- As it currently stands SVHC will continue the process towards updating the regional Hazard Vulnerability Assessment.
- We will open up a survey that will allow you to answer questions directly or upload a copy of your regional HVA.
- That information will be compiled and shared in early 2026 for publication.
